

Jazz Arts Academy is a comprehensive teen jazz experience in a special arts partnership program with the non-profit **Jazz Arts Project** and the Count Basie Center for the Arts.

The 2021 Spring Session will be held as a virtual learning experience that will enable students to hone their skills in the language of jazz. The beginning course (Jazz Essentials 101) will introduce concepts of jazz melody, harmony and the introductory basics of jazz improvisation. The more advanced class (Jazz Essentials 201) will dive deeply into Jazz performance training. Topics covered will include ii-V-I vocabulary, common scale patterns, advanced scales, and Jazz History. Students will leave with an understanding of what (and how) to practice to become a fluent improviser.

Each student will also have 3 private (virtual) lessons. Our teaching artists are among the top echelon jazz musicians on the scene today. (Subject to instructors availability for scheduling)

Requirements: Students ages 13 and over should have been playing their instrument for 3 or 4 years and have a knowledge of at least 3 or 4 major scales and be able to read music notes and rhythms.
